Thought you would be interested and could help spread the word to your friends and family.

I just joined the Children's Liberty League, it was launched on March 15th, 2022 by Margaret Marchand, a NYS school board member, along with Chad J. LaVeglia, the lawyer who won the important Nassau County Supreme Court case – this is the case where ALL of the 10 NYCRR 2.60 DOH regulations (for masking, testing, etc.) were decided to be unconstitutional, unlawful and unenforceable. All regulations made by any Agency must be based on a Law passed by the Legislature and must be in line with the Constitution, Bill of Rights, Civil Laws and all existing laws.

This case is not specific to masks, more importantly – it is vital to maintaining our Right to Representation in the democratically elected Legislature. It is vital to preserving our 3, separate but equal, branches of government: the Legislative, Executive, and Judicial. And it is vital to ensuring essential Checks and Balances between the 3 branches.

The State has mounted an Appeal because they don't want to give up unchecked Regulatory power. But thankfully Chad is determined to fight the baseless Appeal so that we can:

- Preserve our Right of Representation in the elected branch of the Legislature
- Stop the Executive branch's unconstitutional abuse of Agencies' Regulatory authority
- Prevent the unlawful circumventing of the Legislative branch – which results in unchecked rule without Representation

Our Goals are specific and our Mission is clear. The goals are:

Unite: We are more powerful together

Educate: Inform the public of the Appeal and its importance; and of the Agency rules currently being accepted that have no basis on a Law passed by the Legislature.

Lobby: Hire Independent research teams and hire Lobbyists

Legislate: Repeal regulations that are in violation of the constitutional rights of the citizens, block future regulations that are in process of becoming permanent and revamp the checks and balances of the SAPA (State Administrative Procedures Act) process.

The Mission: We need formal unified advocacy, and independent research to be a voice for parents and all New Yorkers who want to protect their freedoms.

If the State's Appeal of Chad's case is successful – it will affect ALL 19 Million New Yorkers. The State's unelected Agencies will have unchecked power to rule us through Regulations that are unlawful and unconstitutional, and Agencies will circumvent our elected Representation in the Legislature.
